In the past, South African society was partitioned geographically along ethnic and social lines with the most striking divisions in urban centers. This course focuses on four key urban areas in South Africa: Johannesburg, Soweto, Cape Town and Stellenbosch. These locales represent a diverse cross-section of South African society and provide the perfect balance for a comprehensive study of South Africa.

The course combines seminars, lectures, and fieldtrips. In addition, students will have opportunities to engage in two weeks of service learning. In Summer 2009, we will partner with the <u>Amy Biehl Foundation</u> and students will service-learn at various Amy Biehl Foundation projects.
